

GAME RULES

Article 1:

The CITY2 SHOPPING CENTER - 123 RUE NEUVE 1000 Brussels is organizing a free game with no purchase obligation, which will take place **from Saturday, March 1st to Saturday, March 8th (excluding Sunday) between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM.**

Article 2:

2.1. Participation in the game is free and without purchase obligation. The following are not eligible to participate: shop owners, shopping center staff, employees of companies involved in the event – suppliers, hosts, bailiffs, as well as their family members – spouses, parents, and children. Only one participation per person (same name or contact details) and per day is allowed.

2.2. The winner eligible for the Gift Pool may choose to have someone else participate in their place. The substitute participant must be at least 10 years old and over 1.20m tall. For minors under 10 years old but over 1.20m, parental or legal guardian consent is required. Winners must prove their age before entering the pool. For minor winners, the Organizer may request proof of parental or legal guardian consent. If the winner fails to provide this proof, the Organizer reserves the right to select another winner.

2.3. Participation in the game implies full and unconditional acceptance of these rules. Failure to comply will result in automatic disqualification.

Article 3:

To participate: Each player **must be a member of the shopping center's loyalty program** (available for free download on a smartphone) and show their membership to the host at the booth. They can then scan the app's QR code on the game terminal. If selected, the terminal prints a winning ticket, allowing them to try and win the ball pool jackpot.

- **Winning Ticket: "Congratulations, you are selected!"**

A player may only participate once during the entire event period.

TOTAL PRIZE:

- **€6,000 in €10 gift cards**

Gift cards must be collected at the shopping center infodesk.

Prizes cannot be contested, exchanged for cash, or replaced.

Gift Pool principle:

Players have 1 minute to find the golden ball among the other balls:

Selected players take turns.

- If the participant finds the golden ball, they win the jackpot.
- If the participant does not find the golden ball, they lose and the jackpot increases by €10.

If the jackpot is not won on the final game session of the day, it carries over to the next day. If the jackpot is not won by 6:00 PM on Saturday, March 8th, it is forfeited.

Only one winner per family (same name or contact details) is allowed for the entire set of gift cards. A player may only participate once per day and during the entire event period.

Article 4:

The organizing company reserves the right to conduct any verification to ensure compliance with this regulation and to exclude any participant who has committed any form of abuse.

Article 5:

The organizers reserve the right to use the winners' photos and contact details, particularly for publication in the press, without any additional compensation beyond the awarded prize.

Article 6:

The organizers reserve the right to interrupt, suspend, or modify this game if necessary. No compensation of any kind may be claimed as a result.

Any dispute, contestation, or question regarding the interpretation or application of these rules will be decided by the game organizers. Any cases not covered by these rules will be settled by the organizing company, whose decisions are final.

Participation in the game implies full and unconditional acceptance of these rules and any annexes or amendments.

Article 7:

Free game with no purchase obligation **from Saturday, March 1st to Saturday, March 8th at City2 shopping center**.
